# **Basic of Disc Golf**

Players throw a disc from a tee area toward a target or "hole" in as few throws as possible.
 The first player to tee off on a hole is the player with the lowest score on the previous hole.
 If a disc lands out-of-bounds or in a hazard, the player receives a one-throw penalty and throws again from a designated drop zone or where they went out of bounds.

4. Players should always be aware of other players and park users on the course and yield to them as necessary.
